Programme Structure

- **Or you can choose Bronze award package with flexibility (more info below)**
- Academic year runs from **September to July (this year its Jan to Dec)**
- **Assessment:** August (Dec)
- **Certificates:** September (Feb)
- Children will be honoured through a special **Award Ceremony (Sep / Oct 2027)**

What We Expect from Parents

1. Ensure **regular attendance** (minimal absences)
2. Maintain a **portfolio throughout all terms**
3. Please **do not lose any artwork**
4. Include any **art done at home** in the portfolio (independent study)
5. Encourage art exposure:
 - Visits to **art exhibitions, galleries, studios, or artists**
 - Take photos of your child during these visits
 - Ask your child to write a short reflection with date
 - Keep tickets/records and send printed copies to class

👉 A larger **A3 portfolio** is recommended

Bronze Arts Award Package

Child need to do 40+20 hours of art learning. So they can do few (maximum 6) in person classes and rest will be through online sessions guidance.

Fee Stucture

1. In person classes at HAC / 1.5 hrs each - term based (£16/session)
2. Online classes through Google meet / 1.5 hrs each - term based (£12/session)
3. The Bronze Arts Award Flexible Package - £500 (no fixed duration)

Important Note

Some sessions will include **written work** as part of the syllabus, helping children reflect on their creative journey.
